



The City of Evans has an active Neighborhood Services Program to help make our neighborhoods more attractive – please do your part and keep your property clean and free of debris!

Trash and Junk Violations and Guidelines

EMC 8.24.060

Trash refers to any material rejected or discarded, including but not limited to garbage, food waste, animal feces, paper, cans, bottles, glass, containers, rags, cloth, or other materials.



Junk is any item located outdoors that is broken, discarded, or not reasonably useable, including but not limited to boxes, crates, salvage materials, discarded fence posts, tires, motor vehicle bodies or parts, scrap metal, bedsprings, discarded furniture and all other household goods or appliances.

The exterior of all properties must be kept free of accumulated junk, litter, and trash. All waste must be disposed of properly and may not be left in a yard, on a sidewalk, on a trailer or in a street or alley.

The **Outdoor Storage** of materials not customarily stored outdoors in residential neighborhoods, such as, but not limited to: **construction materials, tires and household appliances, pickup campers, truck bed covers, or upholstered furniture that is designed, manufactured and intended primarily for indoor use** is prohibited.



Need Some Help Cleaning Up ?

The city hosts a Clean Up Program for residential trash service customers twice a year. You can check www.cityofevans.org for scheduled dates and more information.

Penalties for Violation

If you receive a warning regarding your trash, **PLEASE take immediate steps to clean your property.** A Notice of Violation is your first warning. If you do get a Notice of Violation, you will have seven(7) days to remove your trash. If you do not remove your trash you will receive an Administrative Citation,

- * **\$150 for the First Offense**
- * **\$500 for the Second Offense**
- * **\$999 for the Third Offense**

If you do not remove your junk and trash, the City may also have it removed for you and bill you not only for the violation (\$150 for the first offense) but also for the actual cost of removal plus a 15% administrative fee. If you do not pay that bill, the City will lien your property and/or your property taxes.
