



Evans City Council Election

The Evans Municipal Election will be held Tuesday, April 5, 2016. This is *only* a mail ballot election. All registered voters will receive their mail ballots by the week of March 21st. You are eligible to vote if: you are 18 years old, a U.S. Citizen, and an Evans resident for 22 days prior to Election Day.

ELECTION INFORMATION:

The Evans Community Complex, 1100 37th Street, is the designated ballot drop-off location for the April 5th election. Voters may deliver their ballots to the City Clerk's Office at the Evans Community Complex, between 8:00AM-5:00PM Monday through Friday and 7:00AM-7:00PM on Election Day. Voters can also return their ballots by mail with adequate postage. Ballots MUST be received by the City Clerk's office no later than 7:00PM on Election Day to be counted--*POSTMARKS DO NOT COUNT as delivery of receipt.*

VOTER REGISTRATION
