- **Police Department**

Officer Jon Trahan was honored on Saturday March 23, 2014 by receiving the 2014 Americanism Award from the Evans VFW. Officer Trahan was recognized for his work on a number of important projects which increased efficiency in the Evans Police Department. Some of his contributions include his work on the newly designed police cars, being assigned to the regional SWAT team for the past five years, his work on the police department Organizational Development Team, his work on the CACP accreditation process, and his taking a regional leadership role by hosting a firearms armorer school. Jon is also a recent graduate of Leadership 1.0 and an applicant for Master Police Officer. He continues to be a leader within the police department. We are very proud of Jon's exemplary efforts and successes. Please take a moment to congratulate him!

The City has signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the Weld County Sheriff's Office outlining our respective roles within the regional SWAT team. The team is managed and coordinated by the Sheriff's Office and the police department assigns two officers to the team. The MOU outlines roles and responsibilities of participants, addressing everything from staffing, operations, training, equipment acquisition and maintenance, to media responsibility and liability. The MOU has been reviewed by our attorney and approved by the Chief of Police.
