*Below is a compellation of updates and projects that are either new or have changed since the last City Council meeting.*

**Engineering**

- May 18-24 is National Public Works Week!
- Bids were opened and the Notice of Award was sent for the Evans C Streambank Repair – Flood Restoration Project.
- GLH Construction completed the sediment removal in the ditch at the WWTP. They will continue on the areas near the diversion structure once the area dries up from the recent rains.
- Engineering met with the City of Greeley and CDOT to move forward on an IGA to participate in the design for the 65th Avenue Widening Project.
- Our area has some new faces, we have our Construction Inspector, Leon Blasco, onboard and we have also provided a space for our Utility Management Consultant, Amber Kauffman with Olsson and Associates.

**Public Works**

**Community Development**

- Summer temp staff for Code Enforcement will start this week.
- Planning Commission training, internally, will begin this week. Commissioner training will be held on June 5<sup>th</sup>, and their first work session is scheduled for June 10<sup>th</sup>.

**Operations:**

- The GLIC ditch water ran from 5-1 to 5-12. They will shut the ditch water down ~~be off~~ for about 2 weeks. The GLIC Ditch water will begin flowing again when farmers make enough calls for irrigation water. When this happens, residents using the GLIC system will be able to irrigate with non-potable water.
- The South Platte River Authority's request for a measurement device on the non-potable supply ditch for Neville's Crossing Subdivision has been completed. A River authority employee will help calibrate the device and get it going.

**Waste Water:**

- We are continuing to work on compliance related tasks, aeration, chlorination, etc.
- Working with Amber Kauffman from Olsson Associates on items related to Wastewater issues in the present and future.
- Identifying needs and getting price quotes on supplies and fixtures for the eventual set up of our own laboratory.

**Parks:**

- Tree pruning has begun.
- Bare spots have been sodded at the Cemetery in preparation for Memorial Day.
