➤ **COMMUNICATIONS**

They will start maintenance procedures and repairs within the next two weeks. • Streets - Making a lot of pothole repairs with cold mix asphalt. • Fleet - Ron has been working with the Dealer on setting up the two large trucks we are trying to purchase this year. We will submit the spec'd out costs to Fred and Jacque when we get them. • CITY CLEAN UP PROGRAM is all set up.
