



## **City of Evans Home Day Care Regulations**

December 7, 2005

Chapter 19.04 of the Evans Municipal Code defines “home day care” as follows:

A home occupation providing less than 24-hour supervision of up to 12 children, in addition to any children of the day care provider. Day care homes shall be required to meet all state and local laws and regulations, including, but not limited to, home occupation permits, business licenses, and requirements of the Building and Fire Codes, as adopted and amended in this Municipal Code. Day care provided to one child or two or more siblings, as well as occasional care (one day per week or less), shall not be considered home day care and shall not require a home occupation permit or business license. (Ord. 348-05: Ord. 005-00)

Day care homes require a home occupation permit and business license through the City of Evans in addition to the State of Colorado’s required license. Home occupation regulations are listed on the permit application which is available through the Planning Division and online at [www.cityofevans.org/forms](http://www.cityofevans.org/forms). The business license application is available on this webpage as well. City inspection for compliance with Fire and Building Codes is required to obtain a business license. Day care homes providing supervision to more than five children have stricter Fire and Building Code requirements and building modification may be required.
