

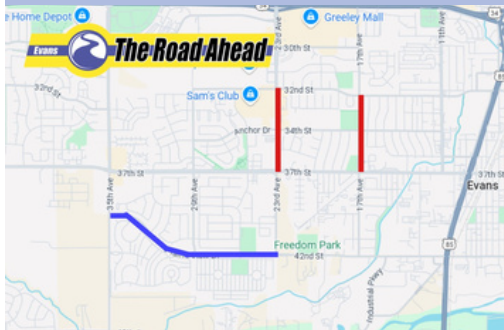

WARMING WEATHER MEANS A BUSY CITY!

As the temperatures rise, so does the number of major projects the City of Evans is undertaking. Work at the Evans Junction commercial development at the southwest corner of US 85 and 31st St. is rapidly progressing, headway is being made at the Arrowhead Open Space park project and the Ridge Park playground installation (pictured below) is nearly complete. The Evans City Council also gave the green light to the brand new Hunter's Reserve Park to be built along 29th Ave. Significant work to city infrastructure planned for this year, including roadways and storm water, is in the beginning stages.

2025 Major Roads Projects are underway. Both 17th and 23rd Aves., between 32nd and 37th Sts., (highlighted in red) will be rehabilitated with mill and overlay work and 42nd St./Prairie View Dr. will receive a full depth reconstruction from 23rd to 35th Aves. (highlighted in blue). Work on 23rd will begin on Monday, April 21, and lane closures will be in place. Thank you for patience while we upgrade three of our city's primary roadways.



City Clean-up Event on May 31

The 2025 spring cleanup event will take place on Saturday, May 31 from 8am-4pm at 3323 1st Ave. In order to continue providing this service, free vouchers will NOT be provided this year, and the event has been scaled back from two days to one. Evans residents may purchase a cleanup ticket for \$15/each at the Evans Community Complex during normal business hours or purchase at the event gate on May 31. See page 16.

City Council Update – March 2025

The two meetings in March saw more steps taken to help make Evans *the* Community of Choice in Northern Colorado. The councilmembers received informational updates regarding an inspection of the wastewater treatment plant, which proved fully compliant with state regulations, as well as an update on design for expanding the plant. Several options were outlined by AE2S, the engineering firm hired by the city to design the expansion, and a path forward using proven technology was the stated preference.

Hunter's Reserve Park project approved!

At the council meeting on March 18, unanimous approval was given to BrightView Landscape Development's proposal to build the brand new Hunter's Reserve Park on 29th Ave just north of Park View Drive. This project will transform what is currently an empty field into a fun neighborhood park with a playground, nature play area, walking trail, shade structure, benches and a connection to Dove Lane. The northern half of the space will remain a functional detention pond for the city's stormwater infrastructure. Work on this project will begin in early May with completion scheduled for mid-August.



At the council meeting on March 4, a 7-0 vote paved the way for the city to begin financing the construction of the new Evans police station. The expected cost of the project is \$35 million. The City had previously allocated \$5.3 million from General Fund Reserves to kickstart the project through site acquisition, hiring of design and engineering teams and procuring long-lead items. An additional \$4 million is available from the Food Tax Fund, leaving approximately \$26 million needed in additional financing. The proposal is to use Certificates of Participation (COPs), a funding mechanism that allows for the issuance of municipal debt and functions as a lease-purchase agreement. The next step is for the city to prepare the required documents for Moody's to obtain a credit rating, after which the city can seek investors for the project.

Contract for annual concrete replacement work renewed for 2025

The City Council approved the renewal of a contract with Burnt Mountain Services for this year's work where concrete which is decrepit, poses a safety hazard or could affect stormwater conveyance will be replaced and ramps will be upgraded to be compliant with ADA standards.

Work began in March and be complete by the second week of May, weather permitting. Concrete replacement work will be done in conjunction with the 2025 major roads projects.

How to report a Street Light Outage



What you will need to report a street light outage

The Pole number where the light is located—the pole number will be on the street side of the pole and will either have two numbers over two, or three over three.

For Example



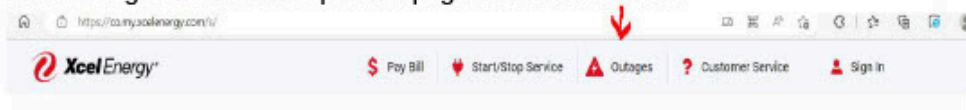
Xcel Energy relies on the information you provide so please be as specific as possible. If the pole does not have a number, then please provide the address behind the pole, or a description of where the pole is located.

For example: The light is located on the Southwest corner of E. 16th Ave and Pennsylvania.

Where to report a Street light Outage?

FIRST: Select the Outages icon at the top of the page as indicated below



NEXT: Scroll to the bottom of the page and look for **Outdoor lighting Outages** and click on **REPORT AN OUTDOOR OUTAGE** as seen below



Next: Click on **Report it now** →

Finally: Enter your information.

1. Your name
2. Your email address: This is used to inform you when the light is repaired.
3. Contact phone number: This will be used to contact you should we have any questions regarding your repair request.

Pole information: ****If an outdoor lighting pole is broken, please call Xcel Energy Customer Care at 1-800-895-4999.

1. Select the problem with the light
2. Pole number: This is where you would enter the two over two or three over three numbers on the pole.
3. Light location: This is the Address where the light is located. Please provide as much specific information as you can.
4. Comments: Provide any additional information that you believe would be helpful

Lastly: You may Add more outages if there are more than one or hit the submit button.

Once you submit the request you will be provided a confirmation number. Keep this number to refer back to if needed.

*****Please note:** Repairs are made in 5 business days unless there is more than routine maintenance is required.
