Moving the City of Evans Forward



Progress, progress, progress!

2026 is going to be another banner year for the City of Evans. This year, look for street sign replacements all across the city. Work on the 49th Street ditch culvert that has caused a long-term closure will be completed soon and the roadway opened. Projects have been put out to bid to install street lights on 37th Street between 47th and 35 Avenues, replace a non-potable waterline along 42nd Street and install a new sanitary sewer main on State Street. Make sure to follow this newsletter for updates all year!



37th Street closed between 47th Avenue and Cheyenne Drive for an Atmos Energy Project; closure will last through April

To meet the increased demand and ensure continued quality service in the region, Atmos Energy will be installing a new high-pressure natural gas line along 37th Street. This project will require the complete closure of 37th Street between 47th Avenue and Cheyenne Drive in the western reaches of the City of Evans. This is a full closure and motorists will need to detour south using 49th Street or north using Highway 34. Atmos Energy informs that the closure is expected to last through the end of April. Council approves site improvement agreement for O'Reilly Auto Parts

At the first meeting of 2026, the Evans City Council unanimously approved a site improvements agreement for an O'Reilly Auto Parts retail store at a property located east of and adjacent to 23rd Avenue, directly north of the Sinclair fuel station. The developer will be responsible for the needed public improvements at the site, which will be completed per the agreement by the fourth quarter of 2026.

City Council gets an upclose look at Evans' new street sweeper and snow plows.

In late 2025, the city took delivery of two brand new, top of the line snow plows with drop spreaders and an Elgin Road Wizard street sweeper. These state of the art pieces of equipment are more efficient and less expensive to operate.

New Evans Police Station construction progressing rapidly



The construction on the new Evans Police Station is progressing quickly. By the first of February, the foundation has been poured, the exterior walls have been placed and work on the roof has begun. This facility will be instrumental in improving public safety in the city. Officers will have more work and training space, their safety, and that of guests to the station, will be increased considerably. The state of the art facility will help with PD retention and recruitment, bringing in the best officers and ensuring the our current officers stay with the city they know so well.

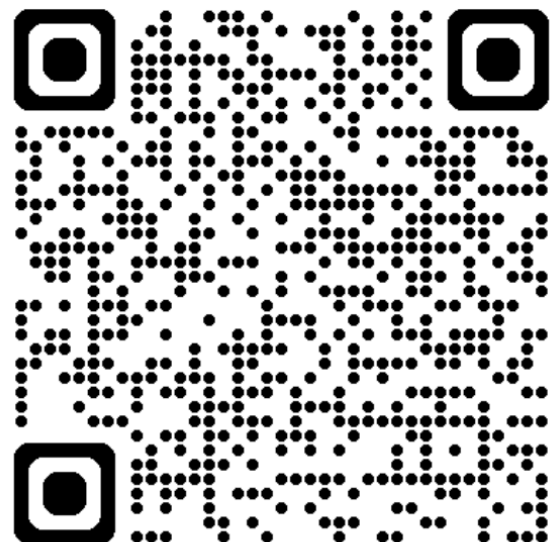

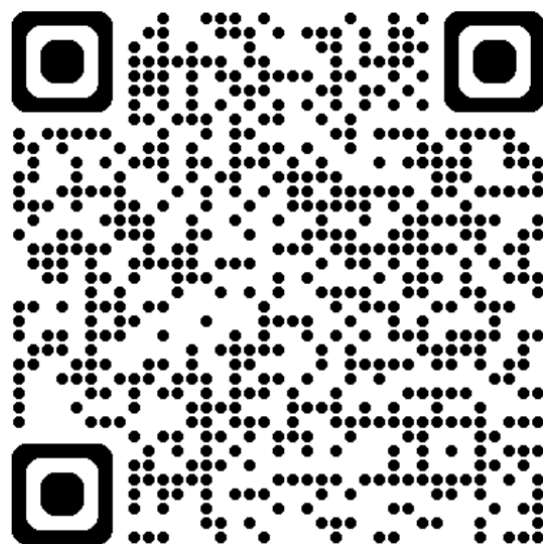

10 Cold Weather Tips



Bring pets indoors

Your pet's fur coat is not enough to keep them warm when temps drop, keep them indoors to prevent frostbite, hypothermia, and other serious cold-related injuries.



Prepare your vehicle

Check your tire pressure and fluids, pack jumper cables, make sure you have extra warm clothing or a blanket inside your car, charge your phone before leaving.



Exercise extreme caution on frozen water

Ice must be at least 4-inches thick to support an average person and at least 6-inches thick to support a snowmobile.



Open cabinets against exterior to warm pipes

Open cabinets under sinks that are against exterior walls to allow heat from indoors to prevent pipes from freezing.



Use a hairdryer to slowly warm frozen pipes

Never use a blow torch or open flame to thaw a frozen pipe; use a hairdryer instead. Make sure everyone in the home knows how to shut off the home's main water supply.



Wear a warm hat when outdoors

Wearing a warm hat in frigid weather helps prevent heat loss and protects you from dangerous cold-related conditions.



Use space heaters wisely

Follow manufacture's instructions when using a space heater, keep all items at least 5-feet away and never leave unattended.



Dress children in multiple layers with hats and gloves/mittens

Children's bodies get colder more quickly than adults and their skin is more sensitive to frostbite - heavy coats, hats and gloves or mittens are a must when going outdoors.



Disconnect outdoor hoses

Ensure outdoor hoses are disconnected from the exterior faucet to prevent indoor pipes from freezing.



Install a carbon monoxide detector

If you don't have one, install a carbon monoxide detector; ensure the ones you do have are functioning properly with new batteries.

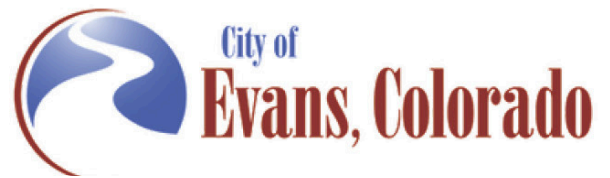

Building Bulletin

Are you looking to put up a shed, pergola, or other accessory structure in your yard? Learn about City code requirements to help set you up for success:

- Permits are required for most accessory structures.
- Plans showing how the structure will be built and materials used must be included with the permit application.
- A plot plan showing where the structure will be located on the property is also required.
- In most cases, City code states that accessory structures must be a minimum 5 feet from the side yard lot line, depending on the structure height, and 20 feet from the rear yard lot line. Properties with alleys adjacent to the rear lot line may have a lesser rear setback.
- Accessory structures like sheds and shops must be made of colors and materials similar to those of the primary structure. If the primary structure has tan siding and a brown shingle roof, the accessory structure must also be made with tan siding and a brown shingle roof.

RECYCLING IS REAL



Bottle = Shirt

The plastic water bottles you recycle can be made into thread for fabric used to make clothing, backpacks, sneakers and more.



Paper = Paperboard

The clean paper you recycle is pulped and made into paperboard packaging for cereal, crackers and other household goods.



Jug = Carpet

The thick multi-gallon plastic water jugs you recycle can be made into carpet for homes and businesses.



Can = Can

The aluminum beverage cans you recycle today will be back on the shelf as a new can in about 60 days.



RECYCLE RIGHT

Only place the following
in your recycle cart

- Clean cardboard
- Paper
- Metal cans
- Glass bottles and jars
- Plastic containers shaped like bottles, jars, jugs and tubs.



Do **NOT** put any of these items in your recycle cart

- Food or liquids
- Plastic bags
- Batteries, electronics
- Clothing or carpet
- Paper towels, cups, napkins or plates
- Concrete or wood
- Styrofoam, scrap metal
- Yard waste





EL RECICLAJE ES REAL

Botella = Camisa

Las botellas de agua de plástico que reciclas se pueden convertir en hilo para telas que se usan para hacer ropa, mochilas, zapatillas y más.



Papel = Cartón

El papel limpio que recicla se convierte en pulpa y se transforma en envases de cartón para cereales, galletas y otros productos para el hogar.



Jarra = Alfombra

Las gruesas jarras de agua de plástico de varios galones que reciclas se pueden convertir en alfombras para hogares y negocios.



Puede = Puede

Las latas de aluminio para bebidas que reciclas hoy volverán a estar disponibles en los estantes como latas nuevas en aproximadamente 60 días.



RECYCLE RIGHT

- Recipientes de plástico con forma de botellas, frascos, jarras y tinas

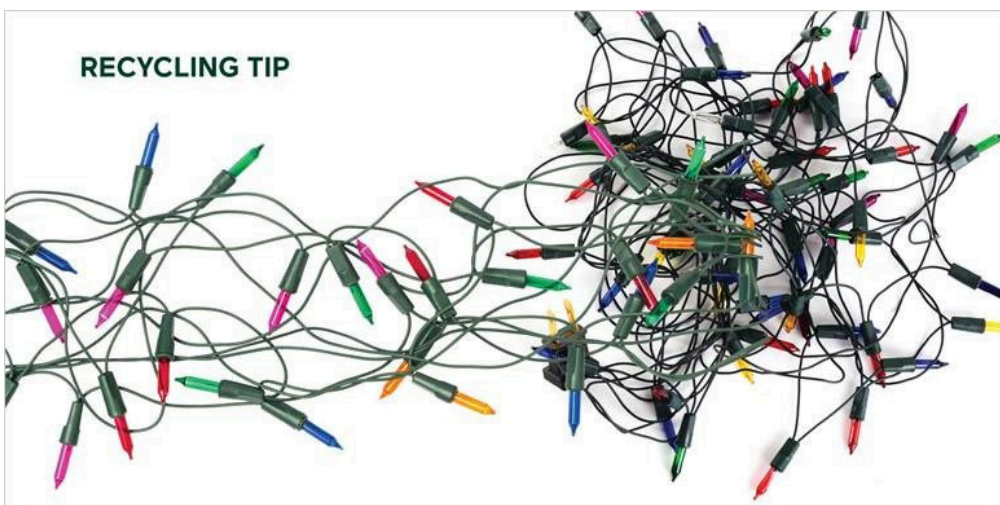

How to report a Street Light Outage



What you will need to report a street light outage

The Pole number where the light is located—the pole number will be on the street side of the pole and will either have two numbers over two, or three over three.

For Example



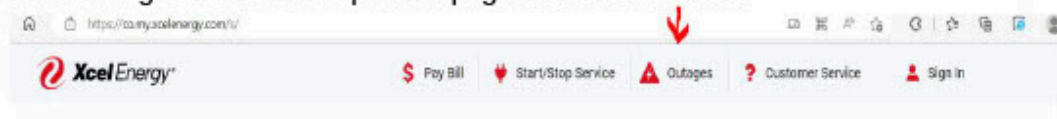
Xcel Energy relies on the information you provide so please be as specific as possible. If the pole does not have a number, then please provide the address behind the pole, or a description of where the pole is located.

For example: The light is located on the Southwest corner of E. 16th Ave and Pennsylvania.

Where to report a Street light Outage?

FIRST: Select the Outages icon at the top of the page as indicated below



NEXT: Scroll to the bottom of the page and look for **Outdoor lighting Outages** and click on **REPORT AN OUTDOOR OUTAGE** as seen below



Next: Click on **Report it now** →

Finally: Enter your information.

1. Your name
2. Your email address: This is used to inform you when the light is repaired.
3. Contact phone number: This will be used to contact you should we have any questions regarding your repair request.

Pole information: ****If an outdoor lighting pole is broken, please call Xcel Energy Customer Care at 1-800-895-4999.

1. Select the problem with the light
2. Pole number: This is where you would enter the two over two or three over three numbers on the pole.
3. Light location: This is the Address where the light is located. Please provide as much specific information as you can.
4. Comments: Provide any additional information that you believe would be helpful

Lastly: You may Add more outages if there are more than one or hit the submit button.

Once you submit the request you will be provided a confirmation number. Keep this number to refer back to if needed.

*****Please note:** Repairs are made in 5 business days unless there is more than routine maintenance is required.
