## City completes lane striping work on 37<sup>th</sup> and 42<sup>nd</sup> Streets

If you've traveled along 37th Street or 42nd Street recently, you may have noticed new, high-visibility lane striping on two of Evans' primary east-west corridors. This much-needed improvement enhances lane visibility, supports safer travel for motorists, and improves overall traffic flow along these busy roadways.

The project was completed in a cost-effective manner and without causing traffic disruptions, thereby delivering immediate safety benefits with minimal inconvenience to the public.

Looking ahead, the City is evaluating the installation of thermoplastic turning arrows in designated turn lanes. These durable, highly visible markings will provide clearer guidance for turning movements and further enhance intersection safety.

## City Council votes to redirect funds to 23<sup>rd</sup> Avenue Stormwater Project

The Evans City Council approved a measure to terminate a contract for the construction of the East Side Storm Sewer (ESSS), and initiated plans to redirect the funding to the design and construction of stormwater infrastructure from the Ridge Ponds to an outfall at the South Platte River. The ESSS, if constructed, would have been capped at both ends until such time as an outfall could have been built further downstream. The City Council, after hearing input from staff, decided a better use of the funds – provided by the State of Colorado for infrastructure work – would be building these improvements that will provide immediate benefits to stormwater conveyance. Evans Chief of Police Randall Darlin presented information at the Council Work Session on March 3 related to the installation of Automated Vehicle Identification Systems (AVIS), also known as “speed cameras” in the city. Chief Darlin outlined for the council how the Colorado legislature amended state statute CRS 42-4-110.5 to allow the expanded use of AVIS technology by municipalities to improve traffic safety.

The Police Department put out a request for proposals and has recommended contract negotiations begin with Sensys Gatso, a step on which the council gave the green light at the March 3 meeting. While additional steps will be taken before the cameras are installed, deciding to implement this program will go a long way towards improving motorist and pedestrian safety in the City of Evans.

At the March 17 meeting, the council gave unanimous approval to a resolution that authorized city staff to submit a grand application to the Colorado Department of Local Affairs (DOLA) to conduct a housing needs assessment, consider relevant updates to the comprehensive plan, and develop a Housing Action Plan. This information will help the city better understand current housing conditions and identify potential gaps in the housing supply.



**New Evans Police Station construction progressing rapidly**

The construction on the new Evans Police Station is progressing quickly. By the first of April, work has begun on the interior of the facility, with HVAC and fire suppression systems underway, concrete work is nearly complete and dry wall has been put up in the southern portion of the building. This facility will be instrumental in improving public safety in the city. Officers will have more work and training space, their safety, and that of guests to the station, will be increased considerably. The state of the art facility will help with PD retention and recruitment, bringing in the best officers and ensuring the our current officers stay with the city they know so well.

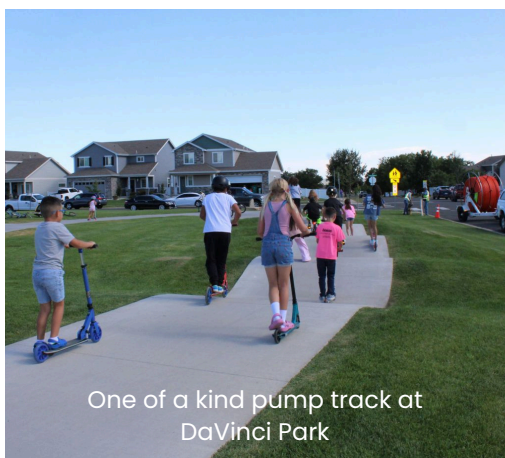
From neighborhood parks to larger community spaces, Evans parks feature:

# Summer Lawn Watering Tips

The numbers above are based on watering 3 times per week. With all sprinkler types cycle and soak can help increase efficiency and reduce runoff. Run 2-3 cycles 45-60 minutes apart. The total run time for the day should equal the number recommended in the table above.

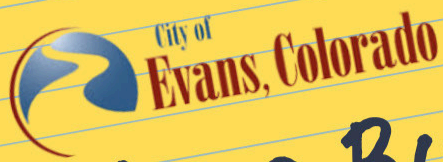
\*Please note that these are recommended run times for our region, if your lawn is suffering at these recommended run times please adjust time and cycles accordingly. Alternatively, if you water less than this and your lawn is healthy, do not water more than needed.

## The City of Evans has Outdoor Watering Policies effective between April 15 and October 15.

Outdoor watering is allowed on scheduled days except between the hours of noon and 5pm.

- Single-family homes with even-numbered addresses shall only water lawns on Sunday, Tuesday, and Thursday of each week.
  - Single-family homes with odd-numbered addresses shall only water lawns on Monday, Wednesday, and Saturday of each week.
  - Multi-family residents or apartments shall only water lawns on Sunday, Tuesday, and Friday of each week.
- Watering mid-day leads to loss of water through evaporation from the sun.

# Building Bulletin



Finding a contractor can be overwhelming and The City of Evans wants to help with some tips on choosing the right person or company for your project:

- Get quotes from several companies/people. The City recommends a minimum of three different quotes.
- You may also consider asking for references from other projects that the contractor/company has completed.
- Ensure that the contractor/company has a City of Evans business license and proof of insurance.
- If a building permit is required for the project, ask to see a copy of the permit prior to the start of any work. Once work commences, ensure proper inspections are being done.
- Avoid making full payment for work before the work is completed and passed final inspections. While a down payment might be requested, a full payment prior to work being done could be a red flag.

## RECYCLING IS REAL



### Bottle = Shirt

The plastic water bottles you recycle can be made into thread for fabric used to make clothing, backpacks, sneakers and more.



### Paper = Paperboard

The clean paper you recycle is pulped and made into paperboard packaging for cereal, crackers and other household goods.



### Jug = Carpet

The thick multi-gallon plastic water jugs you recycle can be made into carpet for homes and businesses.



### Can = Can

The aluminum beverage cans you recycle today will be back on the shelf as a new can in about 60 days.



# RECYCLE RIGHT

Only place the following in your recycle cart

- Clean cardboard
- Paper
- Metal cans
- Glass bottles and jars
- Plastic containers shaped like bottles, jars, jugs and tubs.



Do **NOT** put any of these items in your recycle cart

- Food or liquids
- Plastic bags
- Batteries, electronics
- Clothing or carpet
- Paper towels, cups, napkins or plates
- Concrete or wood
- Styrofoam, scrap metal
- Yard waste





## EL RECICLAJE ES REAL

### Botella = Camisa

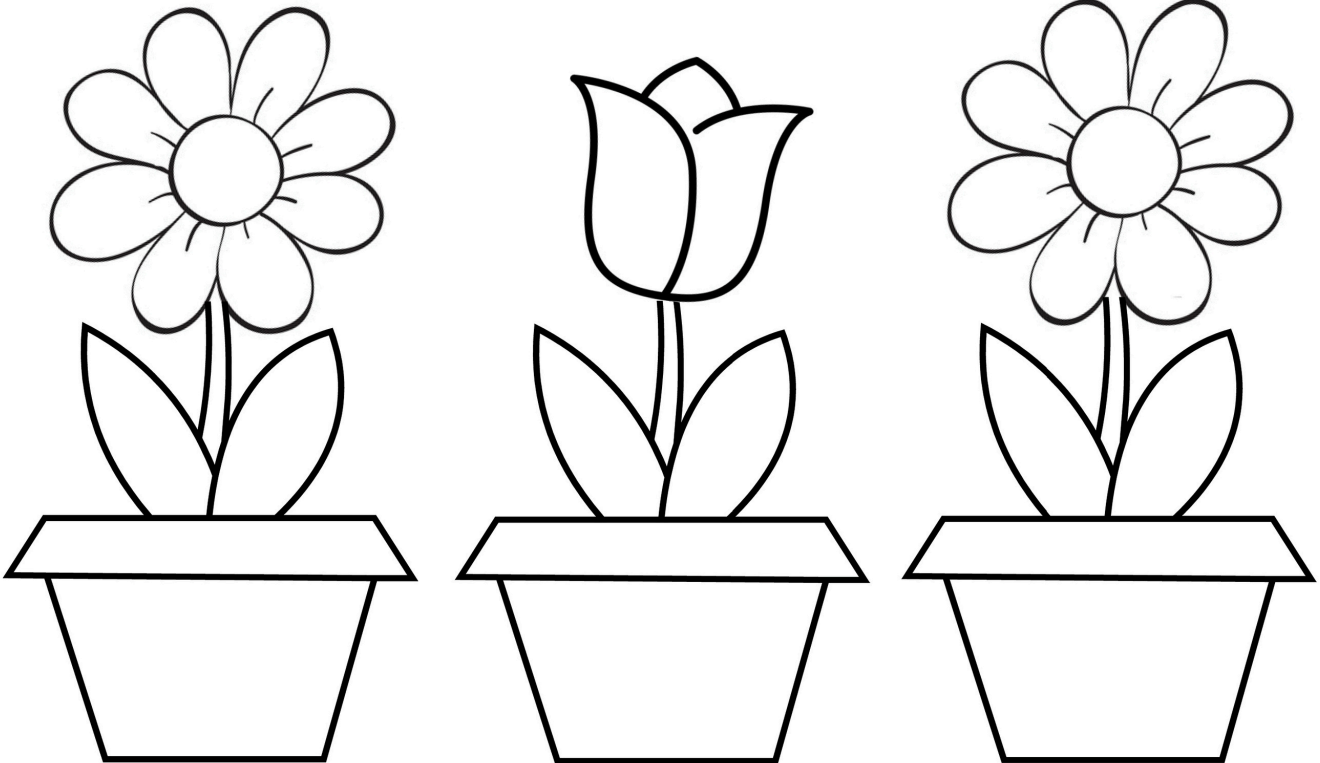

Thin clear plastic containers that open like a clamshell are not accepted in recycling.

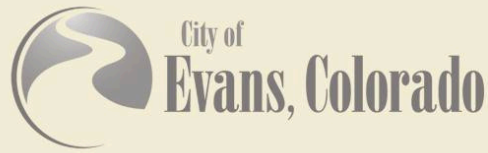

## How to report a Street Light Outage



### What you will need to report a street light outage

The Pole number where the light is located—the pole number will be on the street side of the pole and will either have two numbers over two, or three over three.

For Example



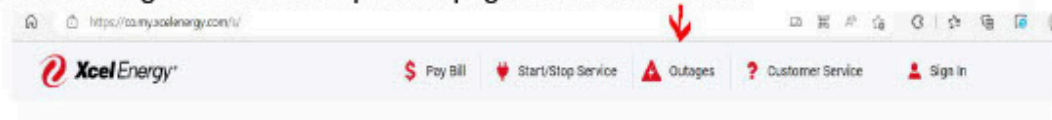
Xcel Energy relies on the information you provide so please be as specific as possible. If the pole does not have a number, then please provide the address behind the pole, or a description of where the pole is located.

For example: The light is located on the Southwest corner of E. 16th Ave and Pennsylvania.

### Where to report a Street light Outage?

**FIRST:** Select the Outages icon at the top of the page as indicated below



**NEXT:** Scroll to the bottom of the page and look for **Outdoor lighting Outages** and click on **REPORT AN OUTDOOR OUTAGE** as seen below



Next: Click on **Report it now** →

**Finally:** Enter your information.

1. Your name
2. Your email address: This is used to inform you when the light is repaired.
3. Contact phone number: This will be used to contact you should we have any questions regarding your repair request.

**Pole information:** \*\*\*\*If an outdoor lighting pole is broken, please call Xcel Energy Customer Care at 1-800-895-4999.

1. Select the problem with the light
2. Pole number: This is where you would enter the two over two or three over three numbers on the pole.
3. Light location: This is the Address where the light is located. Please provide as much specific information as you can.
4. Comments: Provide any additional information that you believe would be helpful

**Lastly:** You may Add more outages if there are more than one or hit the submit button.

Once you submit the request you will be provided a confirmation number. Keep this number to refer back to if needed.

\*\*\*Please note: Repairs are made in 5 business days unless there is more than routine maintenance is required.
