The opening months of 2025 have seen work begin on several major projects all across the City. The components of the brand new Ridge Park playground structure, pictured below, were delivered and crews immediately began assembly. The infrastructure work at the Evans Junction commercial development began in February and will be ready for businesses to begin building this summer. The new Evans Sign Shop began installing new street signs that will increase public safety, establish universal City branding and bring our street signs into compliance with state and federal regulations.

The City identified the Evans Junction property (southwest corner of US 85 and 31st St.) as a prime location for commercial development considering its adjacency to both US 85 and US 34. Developing this space will increase competition, provide jobs and boost sales tax revenue that can be reinvested in City services.

As the calendar turns to spring, residents and visitors will see several significant road construction projects take place across the City. Full-depth reconstruction of Prairie View Drive/42nd St. and mill & overlay work on 17th and 23rd Aves will take place this spring. As we get a little closer to summer, the next phase of the 37th Street widening project (between Stampede Dr. and 35th Ave.) will also begin. We know road closures can be a hassle but these infrastructure improvements are very important to helping Evans continue to move forward and improve the quality of life!




City Council Update – February 2025

February saw more steps taken to help make Evans *the* Community of Choice in Northern Colorado. The Councilmembers received informational updates from WM (Waste Management) and from City Staff on the timeline for the new Evans Police Station Project and the 2025 Community Cleanup Events. The Council also approved contracts for the development of a park in the Arrowhead Open Space and for the annual concrete replacement work all around the City.

Arrowhead Open Space to be transformed into passive park

At the Council meeting on Feb. 18, unanimous approval was given to Tuston Construction to redevelop the Arrowhead Open Space into a passive community park. A design concept was approved by Confluent Design in 2024 and a competitive bid process saw 12 qualified bids submitted. Tuston was the low-bidder with a history of successful completion of similar projects and good references. A not to exceed amount of \$649,870.91 from the Park Impact Fund will be used for this project, below the projected budgeted amount of \$875,000.



The new Arrowhead Open Space concept design was approved by the Evans City Council on Feb. 18, 2025. This space, located along the western gateway to the City, is a perfect location for a passive park space. A walking trail, trees, benches, scenic overlooks, a parking lot, bicycle racks, shelter and picnic tables will all be included. Tuston Construction was awarded the contract for the work, which is scheduled to begin in the spring and completed by the end of July.



At the regular meeting on Feb. 18, the Council approved the next steps in the annexation process for a 19.51-acre piece of land owned by the Sanger family, located east of the Arrowhead neighborhood and north of Hill-N-Park. The petition for annexation was brought forth by the property owners with plans to subdivide the area into three estate residential lots. All requirements under local and state law were satisfied, allowing the process for annexation to progress

Contract for annual concrete replacement work renewed for 2025

The City Council approved the renewal of a contract with Burnt Mountain Services for this year's work where concrete which is decrepit, poses a safety hazard or could affect stormwater conveyance will be replaced and ramps will be upgraded to be compliant with ADA standards. Work is expected to begin in March and be complete by the second week of May, weather permitting.

Business Spotlight - Palomino Restaurant

On any given day, you can walk into Palomino Restaurant in Evans and see a familiar face, whether it's a regular customer or one of the friendly staff you've gotten to know. This atmosphere is what Blake Lucio, regional manager of Lucio Concepts, wants customers to experience in his restaurant.

Specializing in fresh, made-from-scratch Mexican cuisine, Palomino has been a staple in Evans since 2004. This warm, welcoming dining space features art curated by the Lucio family, including the signature palomino on the wall of the front entrance.

Richard and Brenda Lucio, Blake's parents, are the founders of what is now an eight-restaurant portfolio, which includes Palomino, Coyote's Southwestern Grill, Blue Agave and Vatos Tacos and Tequila. But the Lucio family – for as far back as four generations – are a dynasty of entrepreneurs in the Mexican and southwestern cuisine space.

Richard's father – Blake's grandfather – Joseph Lucio, started The Armadillo in La Salle in 1971. Before that, Blake's great-grandmother was one of the head cooks for Pancho Villa for many years. There, she developed her green chili recipe, which the family still uses in its restaurants to this day.

Upon visiting the restaurant, Lucio introduced the front-of-house, kitchen and wait staff with obvious pride. Many employees have been a part of the Lucio restaurant family for many years. In particular, Carlos Hernandez, who runs the kitchen at Palomino Evans, has been with the company for twenty years. In watching the staff prepare food, tend to the kitchen, serve customers and interact with each other, it's clear that employees are proud of their work and enjoy what they do.

The Lucio family is especially proud of the environment at Palomino Evans: "The best thing about being in Evans is the people that frequent our restaurant. They have been supporting us for 19 years and we have come to know so many of them. We love it when we see them 2 or 3 times a week, they all feel like family," says Brenda Lucio. 

How to report a Street Light Outage



What you will need to report a street light outage

The Pole number where the light is located—the pole number will be on the street side of the pole and will either have two numbers over two, or three over three.

For Example



Xcel Energy relies on the information you provide so please be as specific as possible. If the pole does not have a number, then please provide the address behind the pole, or a description of where the pole is located.

For example: The light is located on the Southwest corner of E. 16th Ave and Pennsylvania.


Where to report a Street light Outage?

FIRST: Select the Outages icon at the top of the page as indicated below



NEXT: Scroll to the bottom of the page and look for **Outdoor lighting Outages** and click on **REPORT AN OUTDOOR OUTAGE** as seen below



Next: Click on **Report it now** →

Finally: Enter your information.

1. Your name
2. Your email address: This is used to inform you when the light is repaired.
3. Contact phone number: This will be used to contact you should we have any questions regarding your repair request.

Pole information: ****If an outdoor lighting pole is broken, please call Xcel Energy Customer Care at 1-800-895-4999.

1. Select the problem with the light
2. Pole number: This is where you would enter the two over two or three over three numbers on the pole.
3. Light location: This is the Address where the light is located. Please provide as much specific information as you can.
4. Comments: Provide any additional information that you believe would be helpful

Lastly: You may Add more outages if there are more than one or hit the submit button.

Once you submit the request you will be provided a confirmation number. Keep this number to refer back to if needed.

***Please note: Repairs are made in 5 business days unless there is more than routine maintenance is required.
