



## **Evans City Council Election**

If you are interested in serving on the Evans City Council there will be a **candidate orientation at 6:00 p.m. on January 28<sup>th</sup>** at the Evans Community Complex located at 1100 37<sup>th</sup> Street, Evans. Orientation will include: an overview of City government, the expectations of council members, and elections requirements for candidates.

Evans City Council Members are required by law to be:

- a citizen of the United States;
- at least eighteen years of age;
- free of any felony convictions;
- a registered voter within the City of Evans;
- a resident of his or her Ward for thirty days prior to the election; and
- free from holding any other position in elected public office.

Candidates must collect signatures from 25 registered voters on their nomination petition. Nomination petitions will be available for candidates at the January 28<sup>th</sup> orientation and anytime at the Evans City Clerk's Office after 8:00 a.m. on Friday, January 29<sup>th</sup>. ***Petitions must be delivered in person to the Evans City Clerk's Office, 1100 37<sup>th</sup> Street, Evans, by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, February 12.***

The City Council positions that are open to candidates are:

- Mayor – 2 year term;
- Ward 1 – 4 year term;
- Ward 2 – 4 year term; and
- Ward 3 – 4 year term.

***The Evans Municipal Election will be held on Tuesday, April 5, 2016. All registered voters will receive their mail ballots by the week of March 21<sup>st</sup>.***
