Who: Residents of Evans who pay for their trash service through their water bill.

These residents will receive two (2) free vouchers in their October water bill to use for cleanup.

Each voucher can be used for 1 (one) pick up load.

Residents may also pay cash on-site at the clean-up.

Who Else: Residents of Evans who do not pay for their trash service through their water bill

Proof of residency required: driver's license

### Not Allowed:

- Non-residents of Evans (this includes Arrowhead and Hill-n-Park)
- Anyone without a voucher
- Appliances with Freon, pesticides, paint, motor oil, electronics, TV's, VCR's, DVD players, radios, batteries.
- Tires, car, motorcycle or boat parts.

DO NOT throw any of these items down the drain, in the trash, in the storm drain or on the ground.

## Evans Breaks Ground for new Waste Water Treatment Plant

The groundbreaking for the new Evans Wastewater Treatment Plant was held August 9th, with over 50 in attendance. Officials including City staff and Council, all Weld County Commissioners, the Department of Local Affairs and the Colorado Water and Power Authority participated. A significant amount of the construction for this much needed facility will be underground, so driving along 49th Street, it will be many months before above ground activity will be obvious. Please take care while driving in this area just east of 35th Avenue on 49th Street, as there will be heavy equipment and construction crews working over the next 22-24 months. This critical infrastructure will allow the City to meet regulatory requirements and provide for greater capacity.



## Evans Team Pulls Fire Truck in Fundraiser

Evans Police, Fire District and the Colorado State Patrol teamed up to help raise money and awareness for Special Olympics at the 2nd Annual Greeley Fire Truck Pull. Twenty-four teams competed in the timed event to pull a fire truck 30 feet. The Evans Team time was 11 minutes and 59 seconds. A total of \$3,400 was raised for Special Olympics. Greeley SWAT won the trophy for Fastest Public Safety Team. Way to go Evans for putting muscle behind a great cause!

## Vacancy on Water & Sewer Board

The City of Evans has a vacancy on the Water and Sewer Board. Qualifications for the vacant position include residing within the city limits of the City of Evans and having an interest in the future of Evans, especially with regards to utilities (potable water, non-potable water, wastewater, and storm drainage).

The Water and Sewer Board meets the 3rd Thursday of every month at 3:30 p.m. It reviews and makes recommendations to City Council on annual minimum utility rates, water rights, prices for items such as water meters, annual budgets, and also acts as an appeals board on items that are a variance from policies established by ordinance or resolution as applied to individual customers.
