


35th Ave Widening

Current Work

- City of Greeley is nearing completion of the abandonment of their 4" diameter waterline in 35th Avenue to facilitate installation of wet utilities as part of the widening plans by the City of Evans.
- Utility contractors completed installation of underground conduits for switch over from the existing poles.
- Contractor is grading for west curb and gutter.
- Contractor demoed existing ramps on the east sidewalk and poured back new ADA compliant ramps.



Upcoming Work

- Utilities to begin pulling wire in conduit runs.
- Splice and terminate wiring.
- Begin concrete placement for curb and gutter.

Engineering

- 37th Street Utilities Improvements Project – Final review of construction plans, specifications and bidding documents continues.
- 37th Street & 47th Avenue Widening Design Project – Issued final RFP addendums (RFI). Proposals were due December 20, 2018.
- Evans Ditch Measuring Flume - The survey and analysis report has been completed and submitted to the City for consideration.
- Staff is working on inspections of private development in Hunter's Reserve Subdivision. Canvasback Court was paved on Thursday 12/20.
- Staff inspected private sewer line repair in the Willowbrook Subdivision.
- Staff is working with contractor on utility testing for the Driftwood Plaza Duplexes.
- Staff is currently reviewing the third draft of the Standards and Specifications update.
- Staff is in the process of identifying replacement areas for next year's concrete maintenance contract.
- Staff is compiling information to be submitted to the State as part of the Seven-year update to the Water Efficiency Report.



Police

- Several of our officers drove to Children's Hospital in Denver to participate in the 16th annual Cops Fighting Cancer event. This event is attended by scores of police departments across Colorado and hundreds of officers participate. The event pairs cops with some very ill children at the hospital. The kiddos receive gifts and caring words of encouragement and support from the officers. Thank you to everyone who made a difference in a child's life this Christmas season!



- Santa paid a visit to the Community Center to help us out with Santa Cops. We had a ton of kids come in for gifts, delicious refreshments, and a chance to chat with Santa!
